- Marketing:

 - d. Rebecca Petrella said that VSU is working on licensure to offer online programsofn out state settings (Florida does not allow VSU to offer online programsyet).
- 2. Writing Quality Task Force: The Task Force has met several times since splenglotted a "Dissertation Diven" writing circle for doctoral students. The first of its kind at VSU, the "Dive In" has approximately 10 students enrolled this semester and is facilitated by Dr. Kathe Lowney at the IDEA Center. Plans are to offer an online version in the spring. Dr. Pas Milberessful summer dissertation course, ENGL 8300, had 15 students enrolled. From this course, the Student Success Center hired two graduate assistants as gradition tutors. Later this fall, we will conduct a survey through Qualtrics to seek grade faculty feedback on the writing ability of our students as well as initiatives to improve graduate student writing.
- 3. GRE Scores: Nearly two thirds of graduate programs have switched their GRE requirements to the new scoring scale. The remaining prangs are encouraged to make the change so that applicants will have a clear picture of what is required for admission to their programs.
- 4. UndergraduateDegrees from Novaccredited Institutions:The issue has arisen because there have been some applicants that did not the degrees from regionally accredited schools Rebecca Petrella said that VSU currently requires degrees from accredited institutions, as mentioned in the Graduate Catalog. The Committee was asked to consider this topic for thenext meeting -does your program'accrediting body have a preference?
