If the parent, spouse, or U.S. court-appointed legal guardian of a continuously enrolled nonresident student establishes domicile in another state after having maintained domicile in the State of Georgia for the required the nonresident student may continue to receive this waiver as long as the student remains continuously enrolled in a public postsecon educational institution in the state, regardless of the domicile of the parent, spouse, or Uspecialted legal guardian.
